OAC Rule 21. Interpreters.

A. A party who is limited English proficient, or any party who calls a witness who is limited English proficient, may request that the OAC provide a foreign language interpreter for the hearing.

B. A party who is limited English proficient may provide their own interpreter, so long as the interpreter meets the qualifications of O.A.C.R.P. Rule 21.C below.

C. Immediately prior to the commencement of the hearing, any interpreter must review the "Code of Conduct for Interpreters in Administrative Hearings" and agree in writing to abide by its provisions.
